## About the speaker

Piet holds a Master's in Philosophy and PhD in Systematic Theology. He is Professor of Ethics and the immediate past Director of the University of Stellenbosch Business School and former Deputy Vice-Chancellor of Nelson Mandela University, South Africa. His latest publication is *Contemporary Management Education: Eight questions that will shape its future in the 21<sup>st</sup> century* (Springer 2022). He currently serves as Director of the EFMD Quality Services, participating in Programme Accreditation and the "Deans Across Frontiers" development programme.

## **Abstract**

In this presentation a snap-shot overview (1970 Milton Friedman – 2022 the Ukraine conflict) is given of the increasing and complex array of expectations that society holds of business and how management education has and perhaps should respond.
