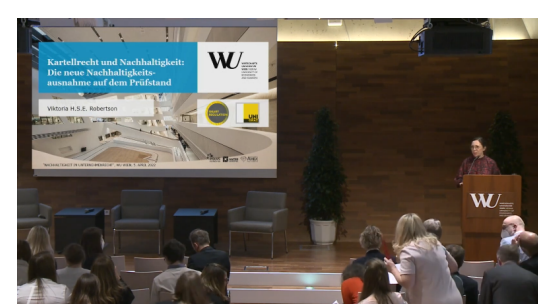

Competition Law in Conversation: Cloud Computing and Competition Law

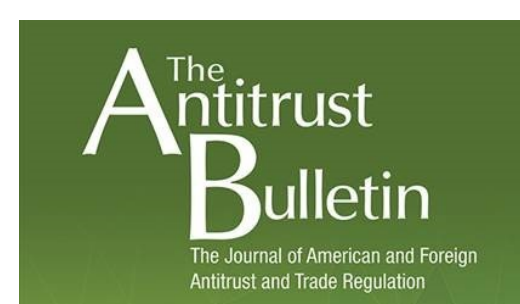
