WU is looking for interns who speak German or English, are reliable, have started or completed an education in business, economics, the social sciences, or law, and ideally have entry-level experience in academic work and research techniques.

The gross monthly salary is \leqslant 494. The interns selected will be employed under a freelance service contract.
