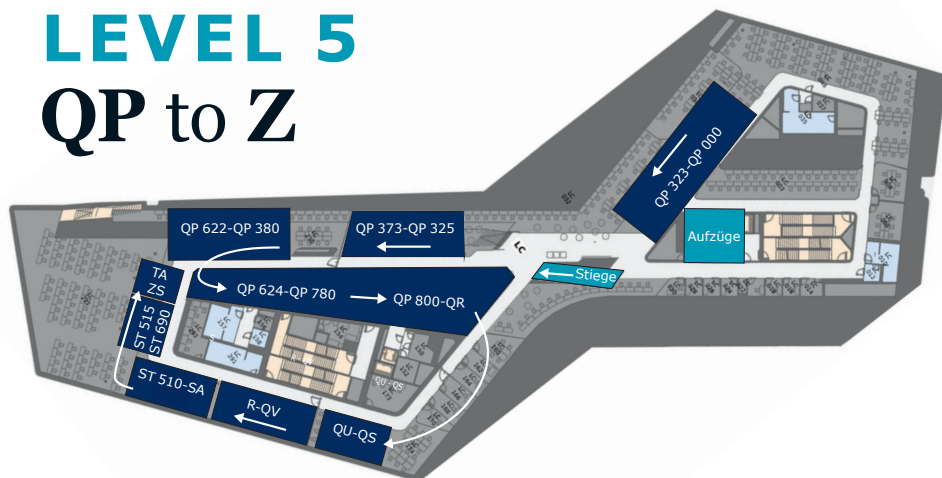

The WU Library also offers an impressive array of digital resources. Explore approximately 150,000 eBooks, access more than 28,000 eJournals and utilize around 170 databases. With a VPN connection, you can discover electronic resources from off campus.



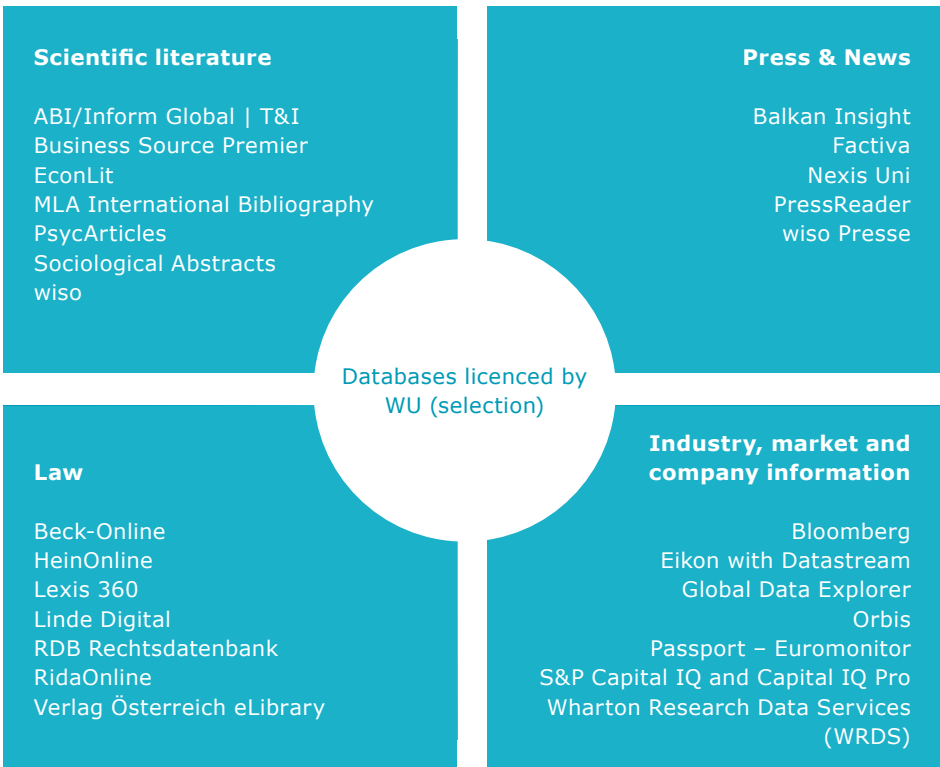


DATABASES

SCIENTIFIC ARTICLES

When searching for a specific journal title or journal article, please keep the following points in mind:

- > **CatalogPLUS** for journal articles: Journal articles are not accessible via the regular catalog, instead you can find them in the CatalogPLUS. You can either directly search for the desired article in the CatalogPLUS or for the journal itself in the regular WU catalog.
- > **Subject databases** for thematic research: For a more in-depth and specific search, you can use subject databases. These databases offer a wide range of scientific articles and specialized information.

PRESS & NEWS

In addition to academic resources, the WU Library provides access to an extensive collection of newspapers and magazines from around the world.

With **PressReader**, you can explore over 5,000 newspapers and magazines in various languages and from different countries. Whether you seek up-to-date news, business reports, or culture features, PressReader delivers a diverse range of current content. You can easily access PressReader on your cell phone, tablet, or computer, ensuring you always have the latest news at your fingertips, no matter where you are.

Visit our **Newsounge** on level 4 to browse through the print editions of current daily newspapers and business magazines. Please be aware that while borrowing magazines and newspapers is not possible, you are welcome to scan excerpts from them for your research needs.

WELCOME TO THE LIBRARY

With over 690,000 printed books, more than 150,000 eBooks, around 540 printed journals, over 28,000 eJournals, and approximately 170 databases, we proudly stand as one of the largest economics libraries in the German-speaking region.

Our library is accessible at several locations with your WU student ID. The main location is the **Central Library** in the LC building. Here, you'll find a selection of books specially curated for your fields of study. You can borrow most of the books, and you have access to the 1,800 self-study workplaces of the library.

In addition we also have the **Library for Social Sciences**: It is located in building D4 and offers a comprehensive collection of literature spanning all areas of socio-economics. The majority of the

book collection is openly accessible and available for borrowing.

We also have a specialized **Library for Law** in building D3. It offers literature covering various domains of legal studies. The library's collection focus aligns with the research areas of the law departments and the subjects taught in law studies. WU students have access to the collection only on site.

LIBRARY INFORMATION

If you have questions or need assistance with your research, please visit the Library Information in the Central Library on level 2. We assist in locating books and journals within the library's collection, provide advice on our database offerings, and give information on using the library.



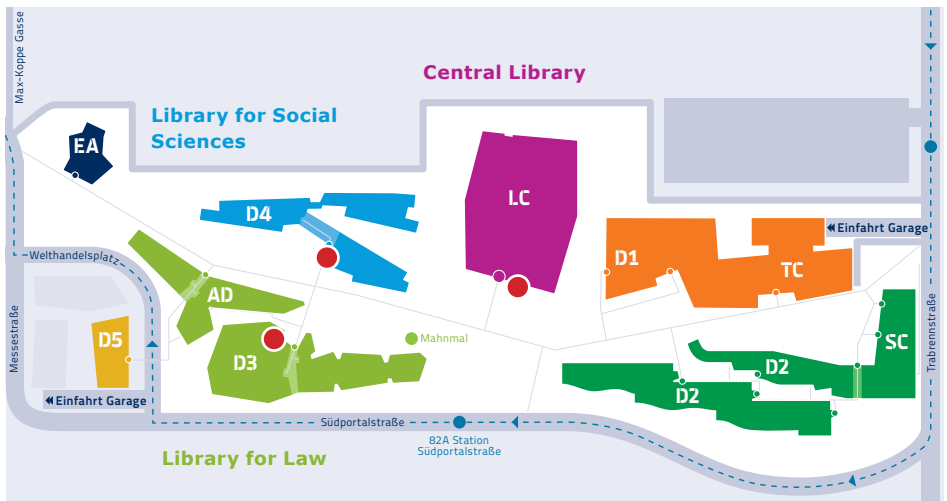
BORROWING & RETURNING

If you want to borrow a book, you can usually take it from the shelf and conveniently borrow it using the self-checkout machines. However, please be aware that magazines and newspapers are only to be used on site.

For returning books, you can use the book return machine located to the right of the library entrance at the Central Library. It allows you to return books even outside the library's opening hours, as long as the building is accessible.

RESERVE & PICK UP

If a book is checked out by another person, you can place a hold on it via the WU catalog. You will receive an email as soon as it is back with us. You can pick it up from the holding shelves behind the front desk in the Central Library within the next three opening days.





Academic Writing

Don't worry if the idea of writing an academic paper feels a bit overwhelming. You're not alone, and the university is here to support you every step of the way. We offer plenty of resources and assistance to help you navigate successfully through the process of academic writing.

Writer's block, stress, lack of focus or motivation - these symptoms can occur when writing seminar papers or bachelor's or master's theses. When it comes to your personal approach or dealing with procrastination and other emotional avoidance strategies, **Student Counselling** offers support.

In **group activities** - workshops, peer groups, trainings and talks - you can learn study & life skills that help you deal constructively with stress, clear your head for concentrated reading and writing, or use your emotional compass for the next practical step. Also You can also take advantage of **individual coaching sessions** if needed.

Reference Management

- › These software programs help you organize your sources, structure your work, and manage citations efficiently.
- › Simply create bibliographies in your preferred citation style, perfect for submitting well-crafted bibliographies.
- › Collaborate and share with ease: Work together in groups on projects and share relevant articles and information seamlessly.
- › Conduct systematic literature reviews effortlessly. Gather results from multiple databases and remove duplicates.

At WU, we offer licenses for **Citavi** and **EndNote**, and the experts in the library are happy to assist you with any questions you might have. If you prefer open-source software like **Zotero** and **Juris-M**, this is also the right place for you!

And here is the best part: Our library's course program regularly offers workshops on these reference management programs. Just take a look at wu.ac.at/en/library > Consultation > Library workshops.

Books, Articles, Scripts for your Courses

TEXTBOOK COLLECTION

The textbook collection is located on level 3 in the Central Library. Books from this section may only be borrowed by WU students - they are essential for your exams. You can search for the books in the WU catalog or, of course, directly on the shelves.

READ!T READING LISTS

In the syllabus of a course, you will often find read!t reading lists. They include books, articles, lecture notes, eBooks, websites, and more. For books, you can immediately see their location in the library. For articles and eBooks, there are links provided, enabling you to access the resources online.

BORROWING TEXTBOOKS



- 5 books at a time
- 6 weeks loan period
- Renewable for additional 6 weeks (up to a maximum of 24 weeks)
- If all copies are borrowed, place a hold on the book

THE LIBRARY AS A LEARNING & CHILL-OUT AREA

Our libraries provide around 1,800 study and workspaces. Whether you are looking for a quiet place to study on your own or want to create a dedicated group workspace with mobile tables on level 4 in the Central Library, you will find the right space here. Additionally, there is a communicative zone with coffee and snack vending machines, as well as an area with sofas and beanbags, perfect for study and work breaks. Customize your learning environment according to your needs and find the ideal spot for you.

PC STUDY AREAS

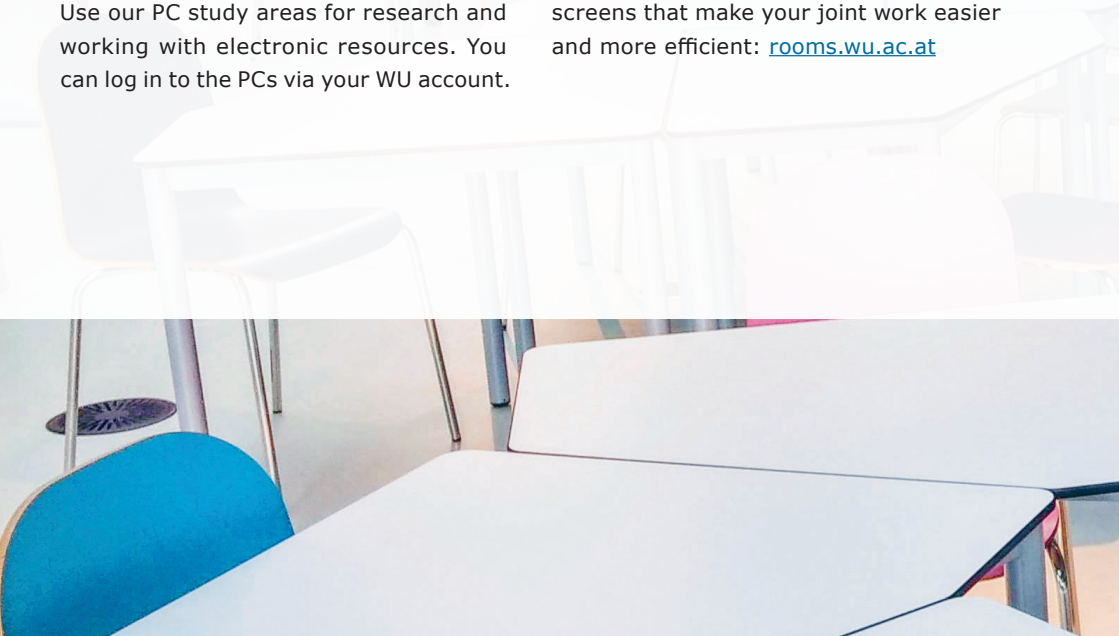
Use our PC study areas for research and working with electronic resources. You can log in to the PCs via your WU account.

TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT

In the WU Library, almost all workspaces have power outlets, allowing you to use your own devices. Additionally, on level 4 of the Central Library, there is a charging station for cell phones and tablets. As a Green Library, we do not use copiers or printers. Instead, we provide free color scanners that you can use to create scans and save them to USB sticks or send them via email.

ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY ROOM

At our library, we prioritize accessibility and strive to provide a welcoming environment for all our users. To ensure a barrier-free experience, we offer a range of facilities and technical tools. These include a PC equipped with a Braille display, a large-print keyboard, height-adjustable desks, a screen reader with speech output, and an OCR program for scanning and reading text templates, among other resources.

CARRELS

Are you working on your Master's or PhD thesis? Book these special rooms for a month to work undisturbed and free of distractions on your assignments at rooms.wu.ac.at.

RESERVING SEATS

When you need a break, take a break timer and set the time you leave your desk. Place the break timer in a visible spot on your workspace. This way, the seat will be reserved for 60 minutes. You can find break timers in the library.

TELEPHONE ROOMS

You will find telephone rooms in the library so you do not have to leave the building to make a call and still do not disturb anyone.

DRINKING FOUNTAIN & BOTTLE FILLING STATION

Stay hydrated while you study: You will find drinking fountains on levels 3, 4, and 5 in the LC and in the Library for Law. There is also a bottle filling station on level 4 in the Central Library.
